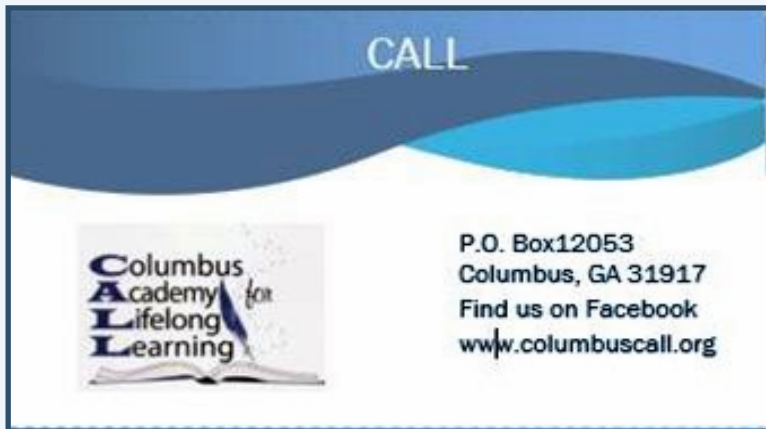

12th at 10:00 a.m.

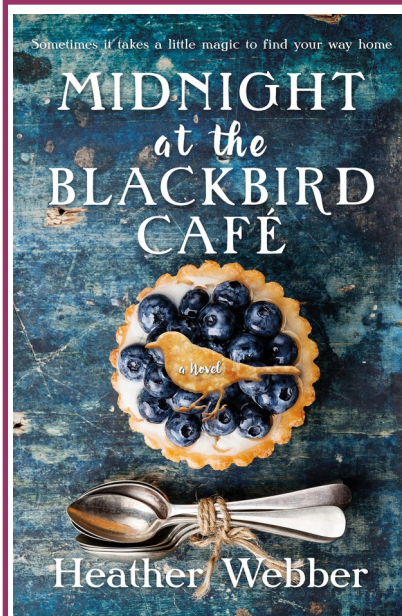
Registration for FALL 2022-2023 classes
