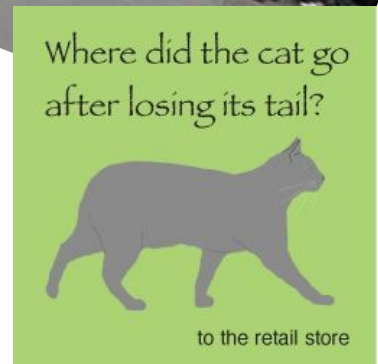
Annual members and people who have registered all 3 quarters do not have to pay. Quarterly members pay \$25. Guests are \$35.
